2019 SCHARLACHBERG RIESLING AUSLESE VDP.GROSSE LAGE®

Vineyard

The grapes come from the oldest part of our top vineyard Scharlachberg. Quartzite & slate from the Devonian characterise the soil in this very warm steep slope. The high water permeability of the poor rocky soil reduces the vigour of the vines and thus promotes the ripening of extremely small-berried, aromatic Riesling grapes.

Vinification

Selective hand harvesting of the highly ripe and Noble Rot grapes. For optimal extraction of the aromatic substances, the grapes are gently crushed and pressed in the winery. After gentle filtration, the crystal clear juice ferments at low temperatures with wild yeasts in stainless steel tanks and is bottled in spring after 4 months of fine yeast storage.

Tasting notes

Crystal clear fruit of peach, apricot and citrus on the nose. Concentrated on the palate with a smooth sweetness which, together with the radiant Riesling acidity, brings out the full harmony of the wine.

Analysis

Alcohol: 7 % vol; Residual sugar: 140 g/l; Acidity: 8,5 g/l; Must weight at harvest: 110° Oechsle
