2021 ROSÉ VDP.GUTSWEIN

Vineyard

The grapes come from Pinot Noir and St. Laurent grown in our vineyards around Appenheim. Exposure: Medium slope with a slight south-west exposure.

Vinification

The red grapes were harvested at the beginning of October 2021 at approx. 88° Oechsle. Whole cluster pressing and fermentation in steel tanks, followed by fine yeast ageing until early 2022.

Tasting notes

In the nose scent of fully ripe wild strawberries. An elegant rosé wine with a lot of juicy fruit on the palate and a lot of freshness and lightness.

Analysis

Grape variety: 80 % Pinot Noir and 20 % St. Laurent
alcohol: 12 % vol.; residual sugar: 6.1 g/l; acidity: 6.3 g/l
